**SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE PERKINS SECTION 222, GENDER EQUITY AND NON-TRADITIONAL VOCATIONAL ROLL-FORWARD FUNDS, JULY 1, 1999 – SEPTEMBER 30, 1999**

**STRATEGIC PLANNING GOAL: II - STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT/PREPARATION FOR POST-SECONDARY EXPERIENCES**

Authorization is requested to accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education (FDOE), Perkins Section 222, Gender Equity and Nontraditional Vocational Roll-forward funds to fund a COPE Summer Employment Program (CSEP) at the Dorothy M. Wallace COPE Center. This award is in response to a Request for Proposal from the FDOE, Gender Equity Administrator.

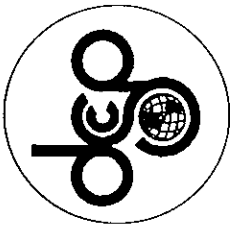
CSEP will provide teen parents with vocational curriculum and on-the-job training in high-wage/high-demand occupational areas, based on the Department of Labor Target Occupational List. It is anticipated that given instruction and practice in vocational-career curriculum and on-the-job training, students who are teen parents will gain the skills to empower them to acquire and maintain employment in the future. The students will be placed in nontraditional workplaces as well as in mathematics and science-related work sites. The initiative also involves strategies geared towards school-to-work.

Grant funds, in the amount of \$19,962, will provide a workshop consultant, child care services for the children of teen parents participating in the project, in-county travel expenses for the supervising teacher, bus passes for students to job sites, computer hardware, and supplies.

No local funds are required.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$19,962, for funding under the Perkins Section 222, Gender Equity and Nontraditional Vocational Roll-forward funds, July 1, 1999 – September 30, 1999; and
2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
