**STRATEGIC PLANNING GOALS: II - STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT/PREPARATION FOR POST-SECONDARY EXPERIENCES  
III - READING/LANGUAGE ARTS**

Vineland Elementary School has been awarded a grant from First Union National Bank. This project is designed to provide students who have been identified as reading significantly below grade level with reading practice, encouragement and instructional materials to increase their reading abilities.

All schools were invited to apply for this grant opportunity via the Federal Programs and Grants Administration web page.

Funds in the amount of \$9,958 will provide instructional materials and supplies.

No local funds are required.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from First Union National Bank, in the amount of \$9,958, for funding a reading tutorial program at Vineland Elementary School, August 26, 1999 – June 30, 2000; and
2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
