SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF SUPPLEMENTAL AWARDS ON TERM BIDS

The purpose of this request is to obtain prior approval of supplemental awards on the following term bids, inasmuch as the estimated requirements, previously awarded by the Board, will be exceeded before the bid terms expire.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, **APPROVE** the supplemental awards on the following term bids, inasmuch as the estimated requirements, previously awarded by the Board, will be exceeded before the bid terms expire:

Bid #003-XX03-STORAGE AND DELIVERY OF FROZEN PIZZA AND PASTA PRODUCTS, to establish a contract, for the storage and delivery of frozen pizza and pasta products, for the Food Service Program of the Department of Food and Nutrition, during the term of the bid, effective July 22, 1998, through August 31, 1999. This supplemental award is requested due to increased usage of frozen pizza and pasta products by the school and students, which has been caused, in part, by problems with the existing food jobbers' delivery of other menu food items. Pizza was offered more often on the weekly menu to accommodate student needs. Last contract usage averaged \$14,035.64 per month, while this year's usage has averaged \$21,825.53 per month. At the time the last supplement was requested, there was a substantial expenditure amount not included, due to invoices not being received and included in the calculation of actual expenditures. The supplemental amount requested is based on the average monthly expenditure amount, times the twelve (12) month contract period, minus the original award and supplemental amount.
