The negotiated agreement includes the following provisions for basic services:

A submittal fee of \$500.00 will be paid for each project that requires submission to the Office of Educational Facilities (OEF).

- 2. The agreement is for miscellaneous electrical engineering projects with an initial estimated construction cost of \$200,000 or less. Projects that exceed this limit after the project has been initiated shall be negotiated on an individual basis.
- 3. The SPC will maintain at least a \$250,000 blanket professional liability insurance policy.
- 4. The term is for a two (2) year period commencing July 14, 1999 and expiring July 13, 2001.
- 5. The agreement provides for cancellation by the Board with or without cause, upon sixty (60) days written notice to SPC. The SPC may terminate this agreement, only with cause, upon sixty (60) days written notice to the Board.
- 6. The multiplier for hourly compensation is limited to 2.45 for extra work approved in advance by staff.

The Principals/Owners for Bosek, Gibson & Associates, Inc. are Bill Cantrell, Sharon Kilpatrick, Ralph Bosek and Michael Gibson.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida commission the firm of Bosek, Gibson & Associates, Inc. to provide Special Projects Consultant (SPC) services primarily electrical in nature, for the Board, during a period of two (2) years commencing July 14, 1999 through July 13, 2001.
