Educating the future leaders of Miami-Dade County is an enormous responsibility. The accountability of this Board to the citizens of Miami-Dade County requires that the professional growth of this Board be an ongoing process.

This Board expects teachers and staff to attend various professional development programs. Board members, as role models, should set the pace for professional development by staying current on challenges being faced by school boards nationally and in the State of Florida.

While time constraints make it difficult for the complete Board to attend the lengthy school board accreditation and training programs offered by various organizations, the Florida School Boards Association has offered to conduct a one-day Boardsmanship Retreat summarizing key issues in governance and administration of a school systems.
