SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO LEASE FACILITIES FOR THE 1999-2000 SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REHEARSALS AND EXERCISES

Authorization is requested for the Superintendent to enter into contractual agreements to lease facilities for the 1999-2000 graduation rehearsals and exercises.

Planning for the 1999-2000 graduation exercises began in October, 1999. In the process of site selection, consideration was given to the scheduling of all graduations within a three-day period, class sizes, accommodation of Board members and district administrators, and unique needs of school communities, e.g., requested dates, times and sites, and available funds.

 - Jackie Gleason Theater of the Performing Arts, June 13-16, 2000, at an estimated cost of \$28,000;*
 - Miami-Dade Community College-Kendall, June 13-16, 2000, at an estimated cost of \$14,000;*
 - Biltmore Hotel, June 13-15, 2000, at an estimated cost of \$1,000;*
 - Joseph Caleb Center, June 14-15, 2000, at an estimated cost of \$500;*
 - Gusman Center for the Performing Arts, June 13-15, 2000, at an estimated cost of 5,500;*
 - UM/Knight Center-Ashe Auditorium, June 14, 2000, at an estimated cost of \$750;*
 - Rental of plants, pianos, crowd dividers, chairs, and other supplies at an estimated cost of \$10,000;
 - *NOTE: Amount indicates estimated costs of rental and other auxiliary services related to the events, including, but not limited to, stagehands, electricians, ushers, police, audiovisual equipment, and parking.
