**SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEE
HOLLIS HOSEIN - SCHOOL BUS DRIVER
NORTH TRANSPORTATION CENTER**

On January 26, 2000, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Mr. Hollis Hosein:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of February 9, 2000, that the School Board suspend you for 30 calendar days from your current position as School Bus Driver, at North Transportation Center, effective at the close of the workday, February 9, 2000, for just cause, including, but not limited to, violation of School Board Rule, 6Gx13-3E-1.10, Transportation-Specific Procedures, violation of Florida State Board of Education Administrative Rule 6A-3.017(2)(e), and non-performance of job responsibilities. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), and 447.209, Florida Statutes, and Article XI of the Contract between Miami-Dade County Public Schools and the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees.

If you wish to contest your suspension, you must request a hearing in writing within 20 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an impartial hearing officer.

RECOMMENDED: That effective February 9, 2000, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Mr. Hollis Hosein, School Bus Driver, at North Transportation Center, for 30 calendar days, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
