SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A CONTINUATION GRANT

AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING THE HIGH SCHOOLS THAT WORK PROJECT, REIMBURSABLE COST

PERIOD, JANUARY 1, 2000 – DECEMBER 31, 2000

The Goals 2000: Educate America Act provides funds through State Education Agencies to plan, develop, and/or implement activities designed to meet national and state education goals. Under this funding initiative, the Office of Educational Planning designed and implemented the High Schools That Work (HSTW) project during the 1998-99 school year. The continuation project is designed to provide training, implementation support, and an evaluation vehicle for schools implementing the HSTW project. The focus is to provide a framework within which students will be motivated to master the essential content of college-preparatory studies as they are applied to real-world experiences. The grant will support HSTW programs at Miami Beach Senior High School, Miami Edison Senior High School, Miami Senior High School, and William H. Turner Technical Arts High School.

Funds, in the amount of \$240,000, will be used for personnel, professional services, travel, and supplies.

Official notification relative to this grant award was received on January 7, 2000, which is after the start of the budget period. The budget period for this award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from January 1, 2000.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept a continuation grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$240,000, for funding the High Schools That Work Project, reimbursable cost period, January 1, 2000 – December 31, 2000; and
- 2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
