NOVEMBER 1, 1999 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2000

The Florida Department of Education issued a Request for Proposals to public schools for additional Carl Perkins funds for local programs in rural areas and areas with the highest percentage of vocational and technical education students. The goal of the program is to increase employment opportunities for program completers and to meet Department of Education mandates and the current trends in the health care industry.

Funds, in the amount of \$38,929, will be used to acquire state of the art, high-tech pharmacy equipment, software and supplies to train students in accordance with industry standards, as well as to produce, print and disseminate an updated curriculum.

Official notification relative to this grant award was received on January 21, 2000, which is after the start of the budget period. The budget period for this award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from November 1, 1999.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$38,929, for additional funding under Carl Perkins, Section 132, reimbursable cost period, November 1, 1999 - September 3, 2000; and
- 2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
