SUBJECT: MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS 1999 UNITED WAY CAMPAIGN FINAL REPORT

Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) has concluded its successful 1999 United Way campaign, with total contributions reaching \$2,303,502, which is \$213,116 more than was raised in the year 1998. Employees raised a record \$1,690,407, and students raised \$613,095, with both figures representing a 10 percent increase over last year.

Under the theme, "25 Years of Giving", all the labor unions and bargaining units represented in the school system joined M-DCPS in this effort and were instrumental in the success of the campaign.

The district's contribution this year is in keeping with its long-standing support of the United Way of Miami-Dade. The organization helps fund more than 64 community agencies with a wide range of services to those in need.
