The Volunteer Miami 2000 High School Fair is an event that will provide students with an opportunity to meet with staff from more than 50 agencies as well as to discuss information regarding agency organization and volunteer needs. High school juniors and seniors from throughout Miami-Dade County are invited to the fair, which is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Wednesday, March 22nd, at the Wolfson Campus of Miami-Dade Community College in downtown Miami.

Students will attend workshops designed to encourage them to volunteer, and will participate in a street fair that includes lunch, entertainment, and a scavenger hunt based upon opportunities for community service.

Because this community-wide project offers the students of Miami-Dade County Public Schools an excellent opportunity to learn more about the agencies they may work with in order to fulfill the community service hours required for graduation, it is recommended that The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, endorse the Volunteer Miami 2000 High School Fair.
