WLRN is a key component in providing services in support of the educational mission of the school district by delivering distance learning, enhancing the Instructional Television Fixed Services (ITFS) channels as well as video on demand, integrating media services, and being a national leader in educational television. In order to ensure that the day-to-day operation of the station is being carried out to support this mission and to support the production of enhanced educational programming, the following recommendations are being proposed:

- Establish and classify the managerial exempt position of District Director of WLRN
  Educational Services, MEP pay grade 23, to oversee the Distance Learning
  entreprenerial educational initiatives of WLRN, the partnerships with the Public
  Broadcasting System (PBS) and the educational functions of WLRN;
- Delete the professional and technical position of Supervisor I, Radio/TV Engineering, pay grade 43; and
- Establish and classify the professional and technical position of Director of Integrated Media Services Engineering, pay grade 46, to oversee the new digital technology tower and new requirements for business and ITFS.

The Division of Wage and Salary Administration has analyzed the responsibilities and compensation for these positions.

RECOMMENDED: That effective March 16, 2000, or as soon thereafter as can be facilitated, The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

- Establish and classify the managerial exempt position of District Director, WLRN Educational Services, MEP pay grade 23;
- 2. Delete the professional and technical position of Supervisor I, Radio/TV Engineering, pay grade 43; and
- 3. Establish and classify the professional and technical position of Director of Integrated Media Services Engineering, pay grade 46.
