**SUBJECT: AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HIALEAH AND THE
SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF WATER FACILITIES TO SERVICE THE MIAMI
DOUGLAS MACARTHUR NORTH SCHOOL SITE**

In order to provide additional fire protection to the Miami Douglas MacArthur North School Site site, the Board must install and connect a water transmission main, one fire hydrant and other appurtenances to the existing City of Hialeah (City) infrastructure (see location map).

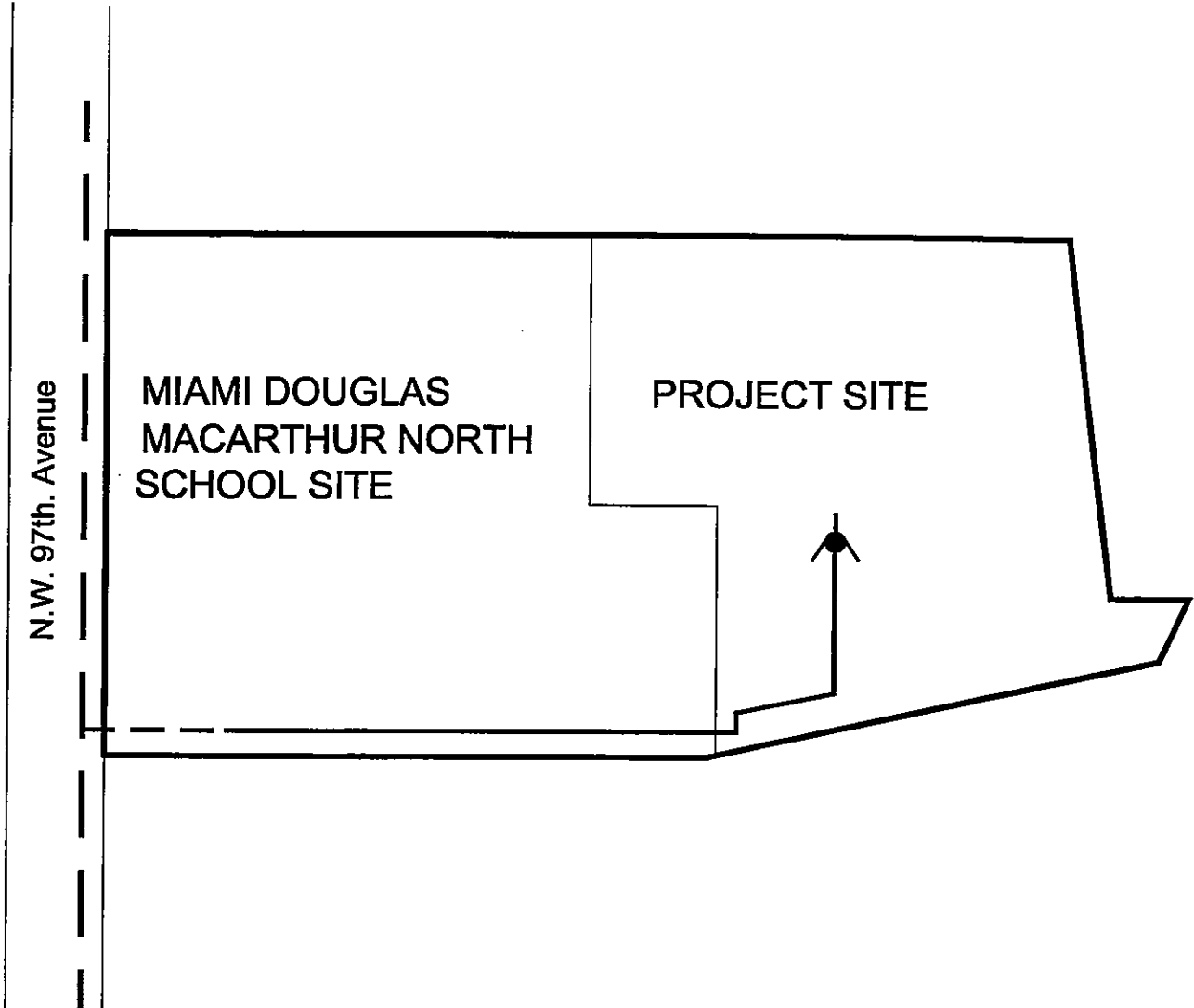
The 15.67-acre school site is located at 13835 N.W. 97th Avenue. A proposed 8" water main abutting the southern edge of School Board property will connect to an existing City owned water main at N.W. 97th Avenue. One new hydrant will be installed. The approximate cost for the installation of these water facilities is \$70,000.

The agreement for the water facilities installation has been reviewed and recommended by the Office of Capital Improvement Projects. Public utility facilities constructed on Board-owned property will be conveyed, with appropriate easements, to the City of Hialeah for future maintenance and operation.





RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent or his designee to execute an agreement with the City of Hialeah and the execution of relevant conveyance documents for the provision of water services for planned improvements at the Miami Douglas MacArthur North School site, at an approximate cost of \$70,000 which is included in the construction contract.
