SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE THE ABSOLUTE BILL OF SALE FOR THE CONVEYANCE OF WATER FACILITIES AT THE SEMINOLE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITE IN FAVOR OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

Adequate fire protection and potable water services for the Seminole Elementary School site have been provided for by the installation of a water line to the existing Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (MDWASD) utility infrastructure. The Board is now requested to execute the Absolute Bill of Sale for conveyance of constructed utility facilities to Miami-Dade County for operation and maintenance (see location map).

The 7.05-acre school site located at 121 S.W. 78th Place. The items to be conveyed include:

<u>Water</u>

- Two fire hydrants, fittings and appurtenances thereto.
- One 8-inch water main extension, fittings and appurtenances thereto.
- One 2-inch domestic service, fittings and appurtenances thereto.

The Office of Capital Improvement Projects recommends that the Absolute Bill of Sale be executed.


RECOMMENDED:
