SUBJECT: PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF BOARD RULES: INITIAL READING

6Gx13-6A-1.02, ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL CALENDAR

6Gx13- 6C-1.02, APPLIED TECHNOLOGY, ADULT AND COMMUNITY EDUCATION SCHOOL CALENDAR

This item is submitted for consideration by the School Board to amend its rule pertaining to the school calendars. The attached proposed 2000-2001 school calendars for Elementary and Secondary Schools (K-12), and Applied Technology, Adult and Community Education, which has been amended to Adult/Vocational Education, were developed by the Miami-Dade County Public Schools/United Teachers of Dade Joint Calendar Ad Hoc Committee. Representatives from all bargaining units were invited to participate. The committee was composed of teachers, principals, district administrators, representatives from all bargaining units, and PTA/PTSA.

The criteria below were considered in developing the calendar:

- 180 days for K-12 students
- 216 days for Adult/Vocational Education students
- 196 days for K-12 teachers (180 days with students, 5 of which are secondary early release days for professional development; 10 teacher planning days; and 6 legal holidays)
- 234 days for Adult/Vocational Education teachers (216 days with students, 12 teacher planning days, and 6 legal holidays)
- Preschool and postschool planning days
- Tandem K-12 and Adult/Vocational Education calendars with recess days and legal holidays matching; common teacher planning days where possible

Two proposed K-12 calendars and two proposed Adult/Vocational Education calendars were presented to representatives of: American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees (AFSCME); Confidential Exempt Employees; Dade Association of School Administrators; Dade County School Maintenance Employees Committee (DCSMEC); Teamsters Local Union 769; Dade

County Council of Parent-Teacher and Parent-Teacher-Student Associations (PTA/PTSA); United Teachers of Dade (UTD); and the Student Government Association of senior high schools for distribution to their members for review, reaction, and selection.

The calendar options proposed by the Calendar Ad Hoc Committee for the 2000-2001 school year offer two choices of beginning school dates. Calendar A (K-12 and Adult/Vocational Education) proposes an opening of school date for students on Monday, August 28, 2000. Calendar B (K-12 and Adult/Vocational Education) proposes an opening date for students on Tuesday, September 5, 2000.

The majority of individuals responding favored Calendar A for both K-12 and Adult/Vocational Education for the 2000-2001 school year. The A calendar for 2000-2001 is reflected in the proposed Board Rule.

Attached are the Notice of Intended Action and proposed rules for amendment. Changes from the current rules are indicated by <u>underscoring</u> words to be added and striking through words to be deleted.

Authorization of the Board is requested for the Superintendent to initiate rulemaking proceedings in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act for the amendment of Board Rules 6Gx13-6A-1.02, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar - 1999-2000, and 6Gx13-6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education Calendar - 1999-2000. The amendment is for Calendars A (K-12 and Adult/Vocational Education) and proposes an opening of school for students on Monday, August 28, 2000.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to initiate rulemaking proceedings in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to amend Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.02, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar - 1999-2000, and Board Rule 6Gx13- 6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar - 1999-2000, for the 2000-2001 school year.
