SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS WITH THE PUBLIC HEALTH TRUST OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO FUND THE DENTAL CLINIC AT LINDSEY HOPKINS TECHNICAL EDUCATION CENTER AND AT ROBERT MORGAN VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL INSTITUTE, REIMBURSABLE COST PERIOD, OCTOBER 1, 1999 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2000

The Public Health Trust of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is a community-based organization established to foster a coordinated system of healthcare for Miami-Dade County and to promote healthy lifestyles. Since 1986, a total of 14 years, the Trust has provided funds to operate the Robert Morgan Center for Dental Care and Education, Inc., located at Robert Morgan Vocational Technical Institute (RMVTI) and the Dade County Dental Research Clinic located at Lindsey Hopkins Technical Education Center (LHTEC).

Authorization is requested to enter into contractual agreements with the Public Health Trust of Miami-Dade County, Florida, for the continued funding of the two dental clinics. The LHTEC will be funded in the amount not to exceed \$130,000; RMVTI will be funded in the amount not to exceed \$55,000.

Official notification relative to this grant award was received on February 22, 2000, which is after the start of the budget period. The budget period for this award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from October 1, 1999.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to enter into contractual agreements with the Public Health Trust of Miami-Dade County, Florida, to fund the dental clinic at Lindsey Hopkins Technical Education Center, in the amount not to exceed \$130,000, and at Robert Morgan Vocational Technical Institute, in the amount not to exceed \$55,000, reimbursable cost period, October 1, 1999 – September 30, 2000.
