SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY, CENTER FOR THE STUDY OF TEACHING AND LEARNING, TO IMPLEMENT THE BEACH STUDENT HEALTH CLUB GRANT, REIMBURSABLE COST PERIOD, JANUARY 26, 2000 - JUNE 15, 2000

Florida State University (FSU), Center for the Study of Teaching and Learning, received a grant from the Florida Department of Education, Office of Tobacco Control. Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) were invited to submit applications to FSU under this initiative. North Beach Elementary School was selected by FSU to receive an award. The purpose of this award is to explore effective strategies that focus on fitness, team sport participation, self-esteem and the development of lifelong healthy habits. All schools and district offices were invited to participate in this grant initiative via the Federal Programs and Grants Administration website.

Authorization is being requested to enter into a contractual agreement with FSU. FSU will reimburse the M-DCPS in the amount of \$21,000. Funds will be used to cover supplies, materials, contracted services, equipment, and substitutes.

Official notification relative to this award was received on February 1, 2000, which is after the start of the budget period. The budget period for this award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from January 26, 2000.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. enter into a contractual agreement with Florida State University, Center for the Study of Teaching and Learning, to implement the Beach Student Health Club Grant, reimbursable cost period, January 26, 2000 - June 2000; and
2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
