SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM

THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CHOICE OPEN ENROLLMENT GRANT PROGRAM, REIMBURSABLE COST PERIOD, NOVEMBER 15, 1999 – JUNE 30, 2000

The Florida Department of Education issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) under the Public School Choice Open Enrollment Grant Program for the 1999-2000 school year. The Division of Schools of Choice responded to the RFP and received a grant award.

The purpose of the program is to promote various models of public school choice and controlled open enrollment that will allow student school assignment using parents' preferential school choice as a significant factor. The program objective is to provide additional support to 14 controlled choice schools to improve student achievement. The program will assist in the further development and implementation of the [Miami-] Dade County Public Schools' Schools of Choice Controlled Open Enrollment Plan. The Plan was developed in 1996, prior to the name change of Miami-Dade County. This grant award will impact approximately 10,000 students.

Grant funds in the amount of \$950,000 will be used to provide schools with additional personnel, substitute teachers, teacher and paraprofessional stipends, staff development, contracted services, materials, supplies, equipment, and transportation.

Official notification relative to this grant award was received on February 25, 2000. The budget period for this award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from November 15, 1999.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$950,000, for funding under the Public School Choice Open Enrollment Grant Program, reimbursable cost period, November 15, 1999 – June 30, 2000; and
- 2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
