**SUBJECT: AWARD OF BID #126-ZZ02 – GREASE TRAP, SEPTIC TANK AND  
STORM DRAIN PUMPOUT AND REPAIR SERVICES**

The purpose of this bid, opened on January 2, 2000, is to establish a contract, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of pumpout and repair of grease traps, septic tanks, and storm drains, for Maintenance and Operations. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price bid, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. Of 51 vendors sent bid forms or card notices of this advertised bid, 13 responded, with 4 bids meeting specifications (not all vendors bid all items), 7 non-responsive bids (1 vendor did not provide a valid Miami-Dade County Liquid Waste Transporter Permit and did not acknowledge addendum #1, 1 vendor did not provide a valid Miami-Dade County Liquid Waste Transporter Permit, 1 vendor did not provide a valid Miami-Dade County Occupational License and did not provide a valid Miami-Dade County Liquid Waste Transporter Permit, 2 vendors did not acknowledge addendum #1, 1 vendor did not provide a valid Miami-Dade County Liquid Waste Transporter Permit, did not acknowledge addendum #1 and used correction fluid, 1 vendor did not provide the name, address and telephone number of three contract customers and did not acknowledge addendum #1) and 2 no bids.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, **AWARD** Bid #126-ZZ02 – GREASE TRAP, SEPTIC TANK AND STORM DRAIN PUMPOUT AND REPAIR SERVICES, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of pumpout and repair of grease traps, septic tanks, and storm drains, for Maintenance and Operations, during the term of the bid, effective March 15, 2000, through February 28, 2001, as follows:
