SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING THE CENTER OF EXCELLENCE-BUSINESS, EFFECTIVE AS OF MARCH 24, 2000 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2000

Authorization is requested to accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education for the Center of Excellence-Business. This program will develop academic and workplace skills required for careers within specific occupational areas.

The Office of Workforce Development Education, in conjunction with Business Technology Education and Miami Beach Senior High School, has developed the curriculum framework, approved by the Florida Department of Education, for the Center of Excellence-Business at Miami Beach Senior High School.

The Center of Excellence-Business has been developed in response to the need for students to possess the knowledge and skills necessary to work and live in a global technological environment. Through the use of an integrated curriculum, students will acquire technical skills and knowledge needed to adapt to emerging technologies and work methods in the technology field. Integration of curriculum concepts will allow students to make the necessary connections among content areas.

Funds in the amount of \$49,935 will be used for curriculum/staff development, equipment, software, and supplies.

Official notification of this grant award was received on June 28, 2000, which is after the effective start date of the grant. This grant award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from March 24, 2000.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$49,935, for funding the Center of Excellence-Business, effective as of March 24, 2000 through June 30, 2000;
- extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
- 3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
