**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM BANK OF AMERICA FOR FUNDING THE TAKE STOCK IN CHILDREN PROGRAM, EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 2000 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2001**

The Bureau of Community Services has been awarded a grant from Bank of America. This program is designed to provide high-quality mentor/mentee training and support. A major component of the program will include training the mentors with necessary tools to work with their mentees on personal and academic goal setting, building career knowledge, college/continuing education preparation, job skills preparation, completing a resume, and interviewing skills.

Funds in the amount of \$10,000 will be used for training workshops, printing awards and certificates.

No local funds are required.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from Bank of America, in the amount of \$10,000, for funding the Take Stock in Children Program, effective September 1, 2000 through June 30, 2001;
2. extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if it is deemed necessary in order to complete the scope of the project; and
3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
