**SUBJECT: PROPOSED PROMULGATION OF NEW BOARD RULE: FINAL READING
6Gx13-6A-1.023, JUVENILE JUSTICE EDUCATION EXTENDED SCHOOL
YEAR CALENDAR, 2000-2001**

The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, announced on July 19, 2000, its intention to promulgate new School Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.023, Juvenile Justice Education Extended School Year Calendar, 2000-2001, at the School Board Meeting of August 23, 2000.

The Notice of Intended Action was published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on July 24, 2000, posted in various places for public information, and mailed to various organizations representing persons affected by the new rule and to individuals requesting notification.

The time to request a hearing or protest the adoption of this rule has elapsed.

In accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act, this new rule is presented to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, for adoption and authorization to file the rule in the official records of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Attached are the Notice of Intended Action and the new proposed rule.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, adopt new Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.023, Juvenile Justice Education Extended School Year Calendar, 2000-2001, and authorize the Superintendent to file the rule with The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, to be effective August 23, 2000.

NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, announced on July 19, 2000, its intention to promulgate new Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.023, Juvenile Justice Education Extended School Year Calendar, 2000-2001, at its meeting of August 23, 2000.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: To establish an extended school year (240 days) calendar for Juvenile Justice Education centers for the 2000-2001 school year.

SUMMARY: Establishes an extended school year calendar for the 2000-2001 school year for the Juvenile Justice Education centers, designating days when students and teachers are in school, beginning and ending dates of grading periods, and holidays for students and employees.

SPECIFIC LEGAL AUTHORITY UNDER WHICH RULEMAKING IS AUTHORIZED: 230.22(2); 230.23(20) F.S.

LAW IMPLEMENTED, INTERPRETED, OR MADE SPECIFIC: 228.041(14)(15)(16)(17) and (43); 230.23(4)(f)(g)(h) and (i); 230.33(6)(f)(g) and (h) F.S.

IF REQUESTED, A HEARING WILL BE HELD DURING THE BOARD MEETING OF August 23, 2000, which begins at 1:00 p.m., in the School Board Auditorium, 1450 N.E. Second Avenue, Miami, Florida 33132. Persons requesting such a hearing or who wish to provide information regarding the statement of estimated regulatory costs, or to provide a proposal for a lower cost regulatory alternative as provided by Section 120.541 (1), F.S., must do so in writing by August 14, 2000, to the Superintendent of Schools, Room 912, at the same address.

ANY PERSON WHO DECIDES TO APPEAL THE DECISION made by The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, with respect to this action will need to ensure the preparation of a verbatim record of the proceedings, including testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. (Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes).
