SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CHOICE OPEN ENROLLMENT GRANT PROGRAM, EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 14, 2000 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2001

The Florida Department of Education issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) under the Public School Choice Open Enrollment Grant Program for the 2000-2001 school year. The Division of Schools of Choice responded to the RFP by submitting a grant application and received a grant award in the amount of \$1,100,000.

The purpose of this grant program is to provide additional support to increase student achievement in 14 controlled choice schools. The program will promote various models of public school choice and controlled open enrollment that will allow student school assignment using parents' preferential school choice as a significant factor. This grant award will impact over 10,000 students.

Funds in the amount of \$1,100,000 will be used to provide participating schools with additional personnel, substitutes, teacher and paraprofessional stipends, professional development, contracted services, materials, equipment, and transportation. Funds will also assist in the further development and implementation of the Miami-Dade County Public Schools of Choice Controlled Open Enrollment Plan.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$1,100,000, for funding under the Public School Choice Open Enrollment Grant Program, effective December 14, 2000 through June 30, 2001;
- extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
- 3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
