SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY'S. CENTER FOR THE STUDY OF TEACHING AND LEARNING FOR FUNDING THE BEACH STUDENT HEALTH PROGRAM; PROJECT CYCLE: AUGUST 28, 2000 THROUGH JUNE 13, 2001

The Florida Department of Health received a Legislative appropriation to fund the American Heart Association Youth Fitness and Tobacco Prevention/Education Program. The Florida Department of Health has contracted with Florida State University (FSU) to administer the grant under this Program for the 2000-01 school year.

North Beach Elementary School was selected to receive a renewal grant award. The purpose of this award is to explore effective strategies that focus on fitness, team sport participation, self esteem and the development of lifelong health habits.

Authorization is being requested to enter into a contractual agreement with FSU, which will reimburse M-DCPS in the amount of \$5,000. Funds will be used to cover supplies, equipment and substitutes.

Official notification of this grant award was received on October 24, 2000, which is after the effective start date of the grant. The grant award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from August 28, 2000.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. enter into a contractual agreement with Florida State University's Center for the Study of Teaching and Learning, in the amount of \$5,000, for funding the Beach Student Health Club Grant Program; Project Cycle: August 28, 2000 through June 13, 2001;
- extend this contractual agreement, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
- 3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
