PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF BOARD RULE: FINAL READING 6Gx13- 6A-1.161, INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS-SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, announced on October 11, 2000, its intention to amend School Board Rule 6Gx13-6A-1.161, Interscholastic Athletics-Senior High School, and the document, Athletic Manual, which is incorporated by reference and is a part of this rule, at the meeting of November 15, 2000.
