## SUBJECT: KIMBERLY HALL v. THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA - CASE NO. SBC 01-314

By letter received by the School Board Clerk on April 11, 2001, the above-named employee requested a hearing to contest her dismissal from employment.

The Office of the School Board Attorney is recommending that the School Board deny the request for administrative hearing as untimely as set forth in the proposed order submitted under separate cover.

This item does not appear in the published agenda. There is good cause to vary from the agenda because § 120.569(2)(a), Fla. Stat. requires an agency to grant or deny a request for hearing within fifteen (15) days of receipt of the request. A decision at the April meeting would be timely. The May Board meeting is beyond the fifteen (15) days and would not permit the Board to comply with the statute.
