Coral Gables Senior High School opened in 1950 with such innovations as streamlined desks, fluorescent lighting, classroom intercoms, and acoustic tiles for soundproofing its study halls. Its innovations heralded a rich and successful chapter in the history of Miami-Dade County Public Schools.

Today Coral Gables Senior High School is considered one of the best high schools in the nation. Among its many honors, Coral Gables was cited as one of the top 100 high schools in America in a recent poll by *Newsweek*.

Academically, numerous national and state awards won by Coral Gables Senior High School and its students have contributed to the school's top standing. It has more Silver Knight award winners than any other school. Its celebrated alumni include former U.S. Attorney General Janet Reno; the first woman to win a Pulitzer Prize in music, Ellen Taafe Zwillich; two astronauts; Olympic gold medal winners; top journalists; leading actors and actresses and heads of major corporations. In recent years Coral Gables Senior High School has been nationally recognized for its Internet projects on the Holocaust and slavery in North America.

Another reason for the school's renown is its international image. The district's first International Baccalaureate program was launched at Coral Gables Senior High School, and today it has one of the largest International Baccalaureate diploma schools in the world, with more than 600 students. Its international student population hails from 50 different nations. The school's International Baccalaureate program and diverse student body are used to attract international businesses by the City of Coral Gables, presently home to 150 multinational corporations.

In commemoration of its splendid record of achievement spanning a half-century, it is proposed that the School Board honor Coral Gables Senior High School on its 50th anniversary.
