On March 28, 2001, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Ms. Angela Y. Bussey:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of April 18, 2001, that the School Board suspend you and initiate dismissal proceedings against you from your current position as School Bus Driver, effective at the close of the workday, April 18, 2001, for just cause, including, but not limited to: non-performance and deficient performance of job responsibilities; violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13-3E-1.10, Transportation - Specific Procedures, and 6Gx13-3E-1.102, Transportation - Zero Tolerance; violation of sections 3.2 and 10.12 of The Handbook for School Bus Drivers, Aides and Operations Staff. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(F), and 231.3605.

If you wish to contest your suspension and dismissal, you must request a hearing in writing within 20 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an impartial hearing officer.

RECOMMENDED: That effective April 18, 2001, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend and initiate dismissal proceedings against Ms. Angela Y. Bussey, School Bus Driver, Northeast Transportation Center, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
