**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING THE EXTENDED ACCESS TO LIBRARY MEDIA SERVICES PROGRAM; PROJECT CYCLE: NOVEMBER 15, 2000 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2001**

The Division of Instructional Technology and Media Support Services has been awarded an Extended Access to Library Media Services Grant. The intent of this grant is to provide a wide range of information resources to meet the curricular needs of students and to provide access to library media services beyond the regular school day.

The following schools were selected for participation by the Florida Department of Education on the basis of their application meeting the required criteria: Campbell Drive Elementary, Gratigny Elementary, Holmes Elementary, North Twin Lakes Elementary, Treasure Island Elementary, Allapattah Middle, and Campbell Drive Middle.

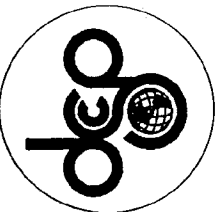
Grant funds in the amount of \$44,152 will be used to provide a certified library media specialist to staff the library media center during the extended hours. Grant funds will also be used for library support staff when the scope and anticipated attendance merit additional assistance.

Official notification relative to the grant award was received on March 9, 2001. The budget period for this grant award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures beginning November 15, 2000.

No local funds are required.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$44,152, for funding the Extended Access to Library Media Services Program; Project Cycle: November 15, 2000 – August 31, 2001;
2. extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency; if deemed necessary, in order to complete the scope of the project; and
3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
