**SUBJECT: EVALUATION AND EXTENSION OF THE COMPREHENSIVE READING PLAN**

At the January 14, 1998 Board meeting, the School Board unanimously supported Agenda Item A-7, Subject: Approval of the Comprehensive Reading Plan. The three-year plan included an evaluation component. The 2000-2001 school year is the third year of implementation. Inasmuch as the final evaluation, which must include test result data, will not be available for several months, it is requested that the School Board be provided with an interim evaluation report at the June 20, 2001 Board meeting.

Furthermore, in order to ensure continuity in our students' development of reading skills, it is also requested that the Superintendent be directed to present a plan for the extension of the Comprehensive Reading Plan for an additional three years at the June 20, 2001 Board meeting. The new plan should include modifications based on the findings and recommendations of the interim evaluation report.

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, direct the Superintendent to:

1. present to the School Board an interim evaluation of the Comprehensive Reading Plan at its June 20, 2001 Board meeting; and
2. at that meeting, submit a three-year extension to the Comprehensive Reading Plan which reflects modifications based on the findings and recommendations of the interim evaluation.
