SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE SCHOOL FOOD SERVICE FOUNDATION TO DEVELOP THE SCHOOLS AS COMMUNITY KITCHENS PILOT PROJECT; PROJECT CYCLE: JUNE 1, 2001 – JUNE 1, 2002

The School Food Service Foundation provides programs and services that support the American School Food Service Association (ASFSA). The ASFSA's Schools as Community Kitchens Pilot Project is made possible through funding from the United States Department of Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Service. The project is being developed by the ASFSA with the assistance of the District of Columbia Central Kitchen. The pilot project will demonstrate the benefits of a school food service welfare- to-work training program. Grant funding in the amount of \$10,380 will be used to provide materials and supplies, printing services, hourly salaries, and travel.

Official notification relative to this grant award was received April 20, 2001. The budget period for this grant award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures beginning June 1, 2001.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

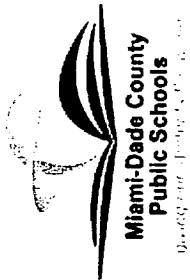
1. accept a grant award from the School Food Service Foundation, in the amount of \$10,380, to develop the Schools as Community Kitchens Pilot Project; Project Cycle: June 1, 2001 through June 1, 2002;
2. extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency; if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amount approved by the granting agency, such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
