**SUBJECT: PROPOSED REPEAL OF SCHOOL BOARD RULE: INITIAL READING:
6Gx13- 2C-1.15, SCHOOL SITE SELECTION COMMITTEES
ESTABLISHMENT AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

At the School Board meeting of May 16, 2001, the Board approved at Initial Reading the amendments to School Board Rule 6Gx13- 2C-1.082, Construction Committees-Establishment and Responsibilities, to include therein the organization and responsibilities of the site selection committee, which will review and issue recommendations on school sites and related school construction planning issues. As a result, the functions that will govern School Board Rule 6Gx13- 2C-1.082, upon Board approval at Final Reading on June 20, 2001, authorization of the Board is requested to repeal School Board Rule 6Gx13- 2C-1.15, School Site Selection Committees-Establishment and Responsibilities, in order to eliminate duplicate and conflicting policies.

Attached are the Notice of Intended Action and the rule proposed for repeal.

Authorization of the Board is requested for the Superintendent to initiate rule-making proceedings in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act for the repeal of School Board Rules 6Gx13- 2C-1.15, School Site Selection Committees-Establishment and Responsibilities.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida authorize the Superintendent to initiate rulemaking proceedings in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to repeal School Board Rule 6Gx13- 2C-1.15, School Site Selection Committees - Establishment and Responsibilities.
