This project is for the renovation of the existing auditorium, the remodeling of the existing kitchen/cafeteria and the upgrade of the fire alarm system at the existing school.

Deductive Alternates

- Alternate No. 1- (A0723A) Renovation of the existing auditorium and existing kitchen/cafeteria and fire alarm system upgrade..
- Alternate No. 2- Demolition and removal of the existing PE shelter and construction of new PE shelter.
- Alternate No. 3- Construction of two new fully functional basketball courts stripped for basketball and volleyball pole inserts.

- Alternate No. 4- Installation of two pairs (4) post-mounted bi-directional signal flashers with required associated signage and connection to available FPL service.
- Alternate No. 5- Relocation of four (4) existing portables by Design Builder to remote on-site location.
- Alternate No. 6- Renovation work at the existing auditorium. Not included in this alternate is the provision and installation of working fire sprinklers, a new fire alarm system and various Safety-to-Life items.

This project is scheduled for completion within 601 calendar days of the contract or on March 4, 2003.

The Design Criteria Professional, Gili-McGraw Architects, recommended award of the contract to the low bidder, Hewett-Kier Construction, Inc.

This project was bid with M.B.E. subcontracting assistance levels of 16% African-American and 6% Women. The recommended contractor will submit M/WBE subcontractors as participants in this project which will be reviewed for compliance with overall M/WBE assistance levels of 22%.

The Principal/Owner of Hewett-Kier Construction, Inc. is Mr. James R. Hewett.
