At its meeting of April 14, 1999 the Board commissioned Turner Construction Company as CM-at-Risk for State School "HHH". This contract provides for construction services to the Board and a Guaranteed Maximum Price for construction.

The Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) by the Construction Manager, Turner Construction Company is in the sum of \$34,558,552 (contingency of \$1,645,645 is included) which covers all required work and includes subcontracts, materials contingency, general conditions, bond, and overhead and profit.
