SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE SOUTH FLORIDA EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING CONSORTIUM TO ESTABLISH FIVE ONE-STOP SATELLITE CENTERS; PROJECT CYCLE: JULY 1, 2001

**THROUGH JUNE 30, 2003** 

Authorization is requested for the Superintendent to accept funds, in the amount of \$835,000, from the South Florida Employment and Training Consortium (SFETC) and to enter into a contractual agreement to establish and provide training for five One-Stop Satellite Centers. The funding will provide core services and support for participants in the Workforce/Welfare Transition/Welfare to Work Programs at The English Center, Lindsey Hopkins Technical Education Center, Robert Morgan Vocational Technical Institute, South Dade Skills Center, and Miami Lakes Technical Education Center. These centers will offer employment information, assessment, and job placement for targeted populations including but not limited to veterans, youth aged 18-21, dislocated workers, individuals with disabilities, and farm workers.

Official notification of this grant award was received on June 26, 2001. This award will continue an existing contractual agreement, effective October 1, 2000 through June 30, 2001, which provides supplemental funding for the operation of four One-Stop Satellite Centers. The grant award provides for the addition of Miami Lakes Technical Education Center and allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from July 1, 2001, with an option to extend the agreement for one additional year.

The grant will be matched by a total of \$290,000 in existing resources from state Workforce Development Education funds.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept a grant award from the South Florida Employment and Training Consortium in the amount of \$835,000, and enter into a contractual agreement with the South Florida Employment and Training Consortium, to establish five One-Stop Satellite Centers; Project Cycle: July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002;
- 2. extend this contractual agreement for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency; and
- 3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency with such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board
