SUBJECT: AWARD REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NO. 228-AA10 – OUTSIDE AGENCIES TO OPERATE APPLIED TECHNOLOGY PROGRAMS FOR LOW-INCOME ADULTS AND/OR INCARCERATED YOUTH (REBID)

The purpose of this Request For Proposals, opened on July 31, 2001, is to establish a contract, at a firm price, to operate applied technology (vocational education) programs for low-income adults and/or incarcerated youth, for the Bureau of Adult/Vocational, Alternative and Dropout Prevention Programs. This is a term proposal which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the price proposed, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount.
