SUBJECT: REQUEST TO CONFIRM THE RENEWAL OF THE CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI-DADE COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO THE NEW WORLD SCHOOL OF THE ARTS

The purpose of this 2001-02 contractual agreement renewal is to reimburse Miami-Dade Community College for an agreed-upon share of the costs of security, plant operation and maintenance, duties performed by the deans, adjunct art teachers and visiting performers, and classroom supplies. This reimbursement will not exceed \$844,299.

A copy of the amended contractual agreement will be provided to School Board Members under separate cover, and will be available for inspection by the public in the Office of Board Recording Secretary and the Citizen Information Center.

The appropriation for this contractual agreement is included in the General Fund of the 2001-2002 Adopted Budget under Function 5103, Program 9117, Object 5310, Location 7901, Fund 0100 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2002.

Traditionally, this contractual agreement is submitted to the Board in February, after the governance agreement has been reviewed by the Executive Board of the New World School of the Arts. Staff, in concert with Miami-Dade Community College, is in the process of revising the timeline for the approval of the governance agreement so that in the future this contract may be presented to the Board in July/August, to better reflect the time certain it covers.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, confirm the renewal of the contractual agreement with Miami-Dade Community College to reimburse specified operating expenses for the New World School of the Arts, in an amount not to exceed \$844,299, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2002.
