SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND ENTER INTO CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS WITH CONTRACTORS TO IMPLEMENT THE COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL REFORM DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM; PROJECT CYCLE: JANUARY 1, 2002 THROUGH **DECEMBER 31, 2004**

The Florida Department of Education issued a Request for Proposal for funding under the Comprehensive School Reform Demonstration (CSRD) programs. CSRD is designed to support activities that are research-based and lead to coherent schoolwide improvements which include all aspects of a school's operations. Each school selected a research-based model from several that were recommended and approved by the Florida Department of Education. All eligible schools were notified of this highly competitive grant opportunity.

Funds in the amount of \$445,412 have been awarded to three schools for the first year of a three-year cycle and will be used to implement each school's selected program. Funds will be used for personnel, contracted services, computer hardware, and supplies.

Authorization is requested to enter into separate contractual agreements with contractors associated with each research-based model in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 per school. The contractors will provide professional and technical services to implement the models. The schools that are requesting contracted services appear below:

Official notification of this grant award was received on January 10, 2002, which is after the start of the budget period. The budget period for this award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from January 1, 2002.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education in the amount of \$445,412 and enter into contractual agreements with the following contractors in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 per contract: MicroSociety, Inc.; Core Knowledge Foundation; and NCS Learn to implement the Comprehensive School Reform Demonstration Program; Project Cycle: January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2004;
- 2. extend this grant award, for up to three years, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
- 3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
