SUBJECT: PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF BOARD RULES: INITIAL READING

6Gx13- 6A-1.02, ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL CALENDAR

6Gx13- 6C-1.02, ADULT/VOCATIONAL EDUCATION SCHOOL CALENDAR

6Gx13- 6A-1.021, EDISON PROJECT-HENRY E. S. REEVES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CALENDAR

6Gx13- 6A-1.022, EXTENDED YEAR SCHOOL CALENDAR

6G-13- 6A-1.023, JUVENILE JUSTICE EDUCATION EXTENDED SCHOOL YEAR CALENDAR

This item is submitted for consideration by the School Board to amend its rules pertaining to the school calendars. The attached proposed 2002-2003 school calendars for Elementary and Secondary, Adult/Vocational Education, Edison Schools Inc. (formerly Edison Project) -Henry E. S. Reeves Elementary School, Extended Year Schools, and the Juvenile Justice Education Extended School Year were developed by the Miami-Dade County Public Schools/United Teachers of Dade Joint Calendar Ad Hoc Committee. Representatives from all bargaining units were invited to participate. The committee was composed of teachers, principals, district administrators, as well as representatives from all bargaining units and PTA/PTSA.

The criteria below were considered in developing the calendars:

- Elementary and Secondary Schools
 - 180 days for students
 - 196 days for teachers (180 days for students, 10 teacher planning days, and six (6) legal holidays)
- Adult/Vocational Education
 - 216 days for students
 - 234 days for teachers (216 days for students, 12 teacher planning days, and six (6) legal holidays)

- Edison Schools Inc.-Henry E. S. Reeves Elementary School
 - 205 days for students
 - 216 days for teachers (205 days for students; five (5) teacher planning days; and six (6) legal holidays)

- Extended Year Schools
 - 210 days for students
 - 226 days for teachers (210 days for students; 10 teacher planning days; and six (6) legal holidays)

- Juvenile Justice Education
 - 240 days for students
 - 257 days for teachers (240 days for students; 11 teacher planning days; and six (6) legal holidays)

- Preschool and post school planning days

- Corresponding recess days where possible

Two proposed Elementary and Secondary School Calendars and two proposed Adult/Vocational Education School Calendars were presented to representatives from United Teachers of Dade (UTD); American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees (AFSCME); Confidential Exempt Employees; Dade Association of School Administrators (DASA); Dade County School Administrators Association (DCSAA); Dade County School Maintenance Employees Committee (DCSMEC); Fraternal Order of Police (FOP); Dade County Council of Parent-Teacher Association and Parent-Teacher-Student Association (PTA/PTSA); and the Student Government Association of senior high schools for distribution to their members for review, reaction, and selection. The calendar options proposed by the Calendar Ad Hoc Committee for the 2002-2003 school year offered two choices of beginning school dates, an opening school date before Labor Day and an opening school date after Labor Day.

The majority of individuals responding favored an opening school date before Labor Day for both Elementary and Secondary Schools and Adult/Vocational Education for the 2002-2003 school year. The selected calendar with a start date before Labor Day was used by the Calendar Ad Hoc Committee as a guide to develop the Extended Year School Calendars for Charles R. Drew Elementary School, North Miami Elementary School, Opa-locka Elementary School, Toussaint Louverture Elementary School, Edison Schools Inc.-Henry E. S. Reeves Elementary School, and Juvenile Justice Education centers.

Attached are the Notice of Intended Action and proposed rules for amendment. Changes from the current rules are indicated by underscoring words to be added and ~~striking through~~ words to be deleted.

Authorization of the Board is requested for the Superintendent to initiate rulemaking proceedings in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act for the amendment of Board Rules 6Gx13- 6A-1.02, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar - 2001-2002; 6Gx13- 6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar - 2001-2002; 6Gx13- 6A-1.021, Edison Project-Henry E. S. Reeves Elementary School Calendar - 2001-2002; 6Gx13- 6A-1.022, Extended Year School Calendar - 2001-2002; and 6Gx13- 6A-1.023, Juvenile Justice Education Extended School Year Calendar - 2001-2002. The amendments propose an opening of school for students on Monday, August 26, 2002 for Elementary and Secondary schools, Adult/Vocational Education centers, and Juvenile Justice Education centers, and Monday, August 5, 2002 for Edison Schools Inc.-Henry E. S. Reeves Elementary School, Charles R. Drew Elementary School, North Miami Elementary School, Opa-locka Elementary School and Toussaint Louverture Elementary School.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to initiate rulemaking proceedings in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to amend Board Rules:

- 1) 6Gx13- 6A-1.02, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar, 2001-2002;
- 2) 6Gx13- 6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar, 2001-2002;
- 3) 6Gx13- 6A-1.021, Edison Project-Henry E.S. Reeves Elementary School Calendar, 2001-2002;
- 4) 6Gx13- 6A-1.022, Extended Year School Calendar, 2001-2002; and
- 5) 6Gx13- 6A-1.023, Juvenile Justice Education Extended School Year Calendar, 2001-2002.

NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, announced on March 13, 2002, its intention to amend Board Rules 6Gx13- 6A-1.02, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar - 2001-2002; 6Gx13- 6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar - 2001-2002; 6Gx13- 6A-1.021, Edison Project - Henry E.S. PURPOSE AND EFFECT: To amend the Elementary and Secondary School Calendar, the Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar, the Edison Project - Henry E. S. Reeves Elementary School Calendar, the Extended Year School Calendar for selected elementary schools, and the Juvenile Justice Education Extended School Year Calendar for the 2002-2003 school year.

SUMMARY: Establishes school calendars for the 2002-2003 school year, designating days when students and teachers are in school, beginning and ending dates of grading periods, and holidays for students and employees.
