SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR SCHOOL BOARD APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE APPLICATION AND AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH NORTH DADE COMMUNITY CHARTER SCHOOL

The School Board approved the charter school application submitted for North Dade Community Charter School by Chancellor Beacon Academies, on December 12, 2001, and authorized the Superintendent to negotiate a charter school contractual agreement for a term of ten (10) years beginning with the 2002-2003 school year.

On February 27, 2002, Mr. Wade T. Dyke, Executive Vice President of Chancellor Beacon Academies, provided Miami-Dade County Public Schools with written notification that they were formally withdrawing from the project. On March 6, 2002, Ms. Sharon "Dee" Donald, Executive Director of North Dade Community Development Corporation, founder of the North Dade Community Charter School, confirmed to Miami-Dade County Public Schools', Division of Schools of Choice, of the dissolution of the agreement between the school and Chancellor Beacon Academies.

On April 3, 2002, an amended application was submitted by Academica Corporation on behalf of North Dade Community Charter School. The Miami-Dade County Public Schools' Charter School District Review Committee met on April 15, 2002, to review the amended application for North Dade Community Charter School. By a majority vote, the committee made a recommendation for approval of the amended application to the Superintendent of Schools.

North Dade Community Charter School will serve up to 600 students enrolled in grades kindergarten through five, with 450 students enrolled in the first year of operation. The charter school will be located at 13850 NW 26 Avenue, Opa-Locka, Florida 33054. The governing board will operate this charter school through a management contract with Academica Corporation, Mr. Fernando Zulueta, President.

North Dade Community Charter School will be open to any student in grades kindergarten through five residing in Miami-Dade County. District schools in close proximity to the charter school include:

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve:

- 1. the amended application for North Dade Community Charter School application; and
- 2. authorize the Superintendent to negotiate with the approved applicant a ten-year charter school contractual agreement, beginning with the 2002-2003 school year, which reflects the contents of the application, as approved by the School Board.

Any pending issues identified by the Miami-Dade County Public Schools Charter School District Review Committee in the recommended application, including minimizing the impact on District schools that are underenrolled, will be addressed satisfactorily in the development of the charter school contractual agreement. The charter school contractual agreement will be submitted for School Board consideration at a subsequent meeting at which time there will be a public hearing to provide for community input.
