SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEE

CAROLYN THOMPSON - TEACHER BROADMOOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

On May 2, 2002, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Ms. Carolyn Thompson:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of May 15, 2002, that the School Board suspend you without pay from your current position as Teacher at Broadmoor Elementary School, for 22 workdays, effective at the close of the workday, May 15, 2002, for just cause, including, but not limited to: misconduct in office and violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties; and 6Gx13-5D-1.07, Corporal Punishment-Prohibited. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), 231.36 and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

You have waived, in writing, your right to an administrative hearing.

RECOMMENDED: That effective May 15, 2002, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Ms. Carolyn Thompson, Teacher at Broadmoor Elementary School for 22 workdays without pay.
