SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE FLARE, FLORIDA LITERACY AND READING **EXCELLENCE, CENTER LOCATED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF CENTRAL** FLORIDA TO REIMBURSE THE DISTRICT FOR TEACHER SUBSTITUTE **FUNDS**

The FLaRE Center has agreed to provide resources to educators on research-based, effective practices in balanced literacy instruction and reading in the content areas to sixteen Miami-Dade County Public Schools. The sixteen elementary, middle and senior high schools submitted an application to the FLaRE Center and were notified of acceptance in late February. The FLaRE Center, a project of the Florida Department of Education, has agreed to reimburse the District the cost of teacher substitutes up to \$17,000.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept funds from the FLaRE Center, located at the University of Central Florida, in the maximum amount of \$17,000, for reimbursement of substitute dollars used to provide professional development on research-based effective practices in balanced literacy instruction; and
- 2. direct Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.

No local funds are required.
