**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM WASHINGTON MUTUAL TO FUND THE SCIENCE ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM AT J.R.E. LEE OPPORTUNITY SCHOOL, PROJECT CYCLE: APRIL 11, 2002 THROUGH APRIL 30, 2003**

J.R.E. Lee Opportunity School has received a grant award in the amount of \$4,000 from Washington Mutual, one of its Dade Partners. The funds from this grant will be used to enhance the science curriculum and delivery of instruction through the extension of learning activities outside the classroom setting. Working collaboratively with community resources and outreach programs, students and teachers will participate in activities with various environmentally oriented institutions such as the Museum of Science, the Deering Estate, Old Cutler Nature Center, and Fairchild Tropical Gardens.

Funds will be used for field trips and supplies.

Official notification relative to this grant award was received on April 11, 2002.

No local funds are required.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from Washington Mutual, in the amount of \$4,000, to fund the Science Enhancement Program at J.R.E. Lee Opportunity School, Project Cycle: April 11, 2002 through April 30, 2003;
2. extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if it is deemed necessary in order to complete the scope of the project; and
3. direct Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
