The purpose of this Request For Proposals, opened on March 26, 2002, is to establish a contract, at a firm unit price, to obtain the professional services of qualified individuals or agencies, to provide scoliosis screening services to grade seven students, for the Department of Comprehensive Health Services. This is a term proposal, which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price proposed, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount.
