ESTABLISH AND CLASSIFY THE POSITION OF LABOR ATTORNEY, LABOR RELATIONS; REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO WAIVE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE INTERVIEW AND THE REVIEW COMMITTEES OF SCHOOL BOARD RULE 6GX13- 4A-1.16, ASSIGNMENT, TRANSFER, AND APPOINTMENT-NON-SCHOOL SITE ADMINISTRATIVE POSITIONS; AND AUTHORIZE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE INTERVIEW AND REVIEW COMMITTEES FOR THE POSITION OF LABOR ATTORNEY

In response to immediate and projected needs in the area of labor relations, School Board authorization is requested to establish and classify the position of Labor Attorney, Labor Relations. The Labor Attorney will provide legal advice and technical support in the areas of labor contract negotiations, contract administration and interpretation, and related labor law issues.

Additionally, authorization of the Board is requested to waive Section II-D and F, of School Board Rule 6Gx13- 4A-1.16, Assignment, Transfer, and Appointment - Non-School Site Administrative Positions, for the selection of the Labor Attorney where a different configuration of the interview and final review committees will enhance the interview and selection process.
