Mr. Earnest Perkins joined our school district as an assistant football coach at Miami Edison Senior High School in 1980 and soon became its head football coach, served as a health education instructor and head football coach at Coral Reef Senior High School for several years and currently is head football coach at North Miami Senior High School. Mr. Perkins has received national recognition for sticking to a regimen that helps produce gentlemen and scholars as well as running backs and offensive linemen.

Believing that earning an A is more important than making a touchdown, study hall is mandatory for his football players who also are required to wear a shirt and tie and to carry a briefcase every Monday. Last year 12 out of 17 of his players who graduated went to college.

Bringing in etiquette teachers, SAT tutors and college recruiters is all part of his effort to turn his players into well-educated, well-mannered teenagers. Mr. Perkins is deserving of being recognized by the Board for his outstanding effort to help ensure that football players are not only good athletes, but achievers and well-rounded young men as well.
