**SUBJECT: AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES AND THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF WASTEWATER FACILITIES TO SERVICE THE WEST LABORATORY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITE PROJECT NO. A0762C**

In order to provide wastewater services to the West Laboratory Elementary School site, and in order to comply with the consent agreement between The Department of Environmental Resource Management (DERM) and the School Board of Miami-Dade County, executed on May 13, 1998, the Board must install and connect a gravity sewer main, private pump station and other appurtenances to the existing City of Coral Gables (City) infrastructure (see location map).

The 10-acre school site is located at 5300 Carillo Street, Coral Gables, Florida. A proposed 8" sewer force main will connect to an existing City-owned 24-inch force main north of Ponce de Leon, on Carillo Street. The Board has agreed to maintain the sewer force main that serves the West Laboratory Elementary School site. The approximate cost for the installation of these wastewater facilities is \$85,215.

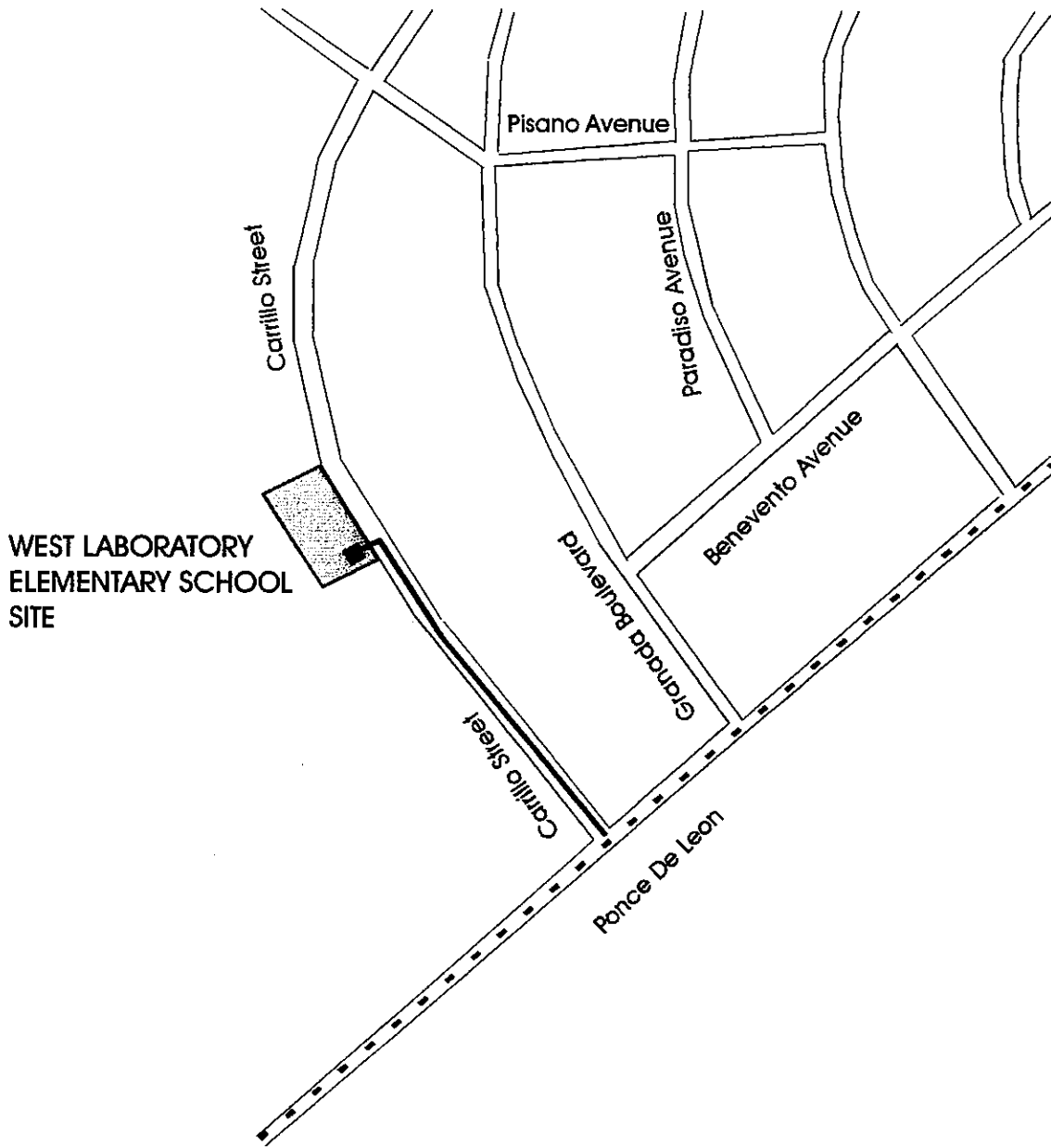
The agreement for the wastewater facilities installation and maintenance has been reviewed and recommended by the Office of Capital Improvement Projects and the School Board Attorney's Office.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent or his designee to execute an agreement with the City of Coral Gables for the provision and maintenance of wastewater services at the West Laboratory Elementary School site, Project No. A0762C, at an approximate cost of \$85,215 which is included in the construction contract.
