SUBJECT: EXTEND CONTRACT NO. 221-ZZ10 – APPLICANT – OUTSIDE AGENCIES QUALIFIED TO OPERATE ALTERNATIVE PROGRAMS FOR M-DCPS AT-RISK STUDENTS

The purpose of the Request For Proposals, opened on May 16, 2000, was to establish a contract, at firm prices, to provide services for students in at-risk alternative education programs, for the Office of Adult/Vocational and Alternative Education. The terms of agreement, as contained in the contract, awarded by the Board on June 21, 2000, and extended on June 20, 2001, provided, that by mutual agreement between the successful vendors and The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, the contract may be extended for two (2) additional one (1) year periods. The contract is currently in its first extension period. The awardees have agreed to extend for the second one (1) year extension period, by letter, on file. It is considered to be in the best interest of the Board to extend this contract, for an additional one (1) year period, at the current prices, to benefit from fixed prices, during the next twelve (12) months, inasmuch as the Consumer Price Index (CPI), for education and communication, as of February 2002, indicated an increase of 3.2%.
