SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF RESIGNATION

Mr. Lawrence W. Holborow submitted his resignation to Miami-Dade Schools Police Department on August 20, 2002, to take effect on August 30, 2002. Prior to his resignation, the School Board was in the process of determining whether cause existed for disciplinary action.

Upon consultation with the School Board Attorney, the Office of Professional Standards recommends that the resignation be accepted as achieving the objectives sought by the School Board in the case. Acceptance of the resignation does not alter the following effects of the employment termination:

- prevention of any future employment in any capacity by the Miami-Dade County Public Schools;
- retention of the information regarding the dismissal action by the Superintendent of Schools as a matter of official record; and
- notification of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement as required in Florida State Statute, Chapter 943.

Acceptance of the resignation will also obviate the requirement for further legal actions by the School Board.

This item was not published in the regular agenda. There is good cause to vary from the agenda because the employee may rescind the resignation prior to Board action.

RECOMMENDED: That the School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida accept the resignation of Mr. Lawrence W. Holborow, Patrol Officer, Miami-Dade Schools Police Department, effective August 29, 2002, at the close of the workday.
