SUBJECT: COMMISSIONING OF ARCHITEKNICS ARCHITECTS & PLANNERS, CORZO CASTELLA CARBALLO THOMPSON SALMAN, P.A., LANDERA ASSOCIATES, P.A., LIVS ASSOCIATES, AND POST BUCKLEY SCHUH & JERNIGAN, TO PROVIDE ARCHITECTURAL/ENGINEERING PROJECTS CONSULTANT (A/EPC) SERVICES FOR A TWO-YEAR TERM FOR MISCELLANEOUS PROJECTS

Staff has completed the selection process for five (5) firms to provide Architectural/Engineering Projects Consultant (A/EPC) services for a two-year term. Twenty-two (22) firms applied and on July 24, 2002, the Selection Committee interviewed the following ten (10) firms:

Of the above, the firms of Achiteknic Architects and Planners (Architeknic), Corzo Castella Carballo Thompson Salman, P.A. (C3TS), Landera Associates, P.A. (Landera), LIVS Associates (LIVS), and Post Buckley Schuh & Jernigan (PBS&J), were the five highest ranked firms. 1. Site Visitations

At the Board's option, the A/EPC firms will conduct on-site observation visits for the following fees:

2. Verification of Existing Field Conditions

For development of record drawings and verification of field conditions, the A/EPC's fee, for all firms, shall be as follows:

3. The Board and the A/EPC must agree in writing prior to the commencement of work for projects up to \$50,000 on the maximum number of hours and a not-to-exceed amount, or in the case of a lump sum fee, the amount for each applicable project.
4. The multiplier for hourly compensation was limited to 2.45. This rate is subject to audit by the Board and could be adjusted as the result of audit findings.
5. The multiplier for Direct Personnel Expense, for assignment of A/EPC technical staff to specific projects and working in offices other than the A/EPC's own offices, shall be limited to 1.70 multiplier times the hourly rate negotiated for the assignment.

6. **Insurance**

The A/EPC will maintain at least a \$1,000,000 professional liability insurance policy with a maximum deductible of \$15,000. No reimbursement for insurance premium is included, as above fees are inclusive of insurance cost.

7. **Other Agreement Conditions**

The agreements provide for cancellation by the Board, with or without cause, upon sixty (60) days written notice to the A/EPC. The A/EPC may terminate the agreement only with cause upon sixty (60) days written notice to the Board.

8. The term of these agreements shall be for a two-year period, commencing October 24, 2002 through October 23, 2004, with the second year being at the Board's option. Since the second year is at the Board's option, the second year must be approved and ratified by the Board prior to its commencement.
